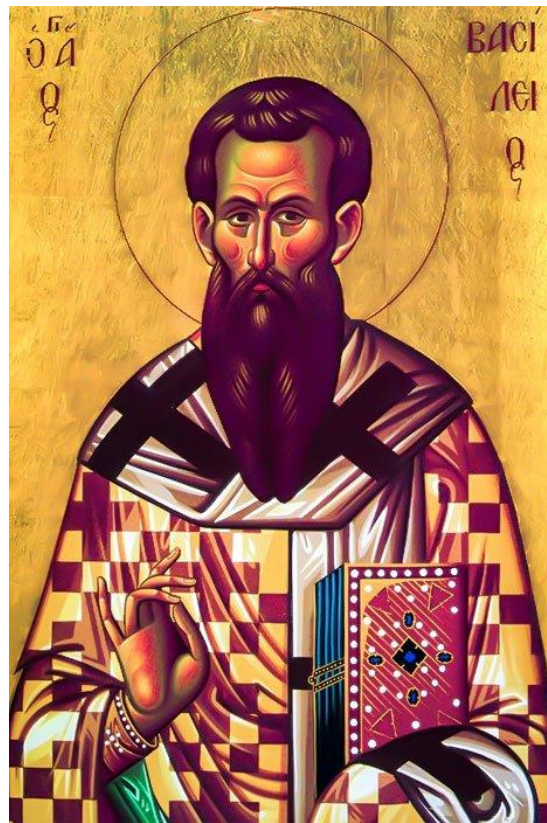

READER'S SERVICE

Leader: Through the prayers of our holy fathers, Oh Lord Jesus Christ, Have mercy upon us and save us. Amen.

O Heavenly King, the Comforter, the Spirit of Truth, Who art everywhere and fillest all things; Treasury of Good Things, and Giver of Life - come and abide in us, and cleanse us from every impurity, and save our souls, O Good One.

Holy God, Holy Mighty, Holy Immortal: have mercy on us. *(Thrice)*

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

O most Holy Trinity, have mercy on us. O Lord, cleanse us from our sins. O Master, pardon our transgressions. O Holy One, visit and heal our infirmities, for Thy name's sake.

Lord, have mercy. *(Thrice)*

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; both now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name. Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us, and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

PSALM 50

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Thy great mercy;

According to the multitude of Thy tender mercies, blot out mine iniquity.

Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

For I acknowledge mine iniquity, and my sin is ever before me.

Against Thee only have I sinned and done evil in Thy sight.

That Thou mightest be justified in Thy words and prevail when Thou art judged.

For behold, I was shaped in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.

For behold, Thou hast loved truth; the unclear and hidden things of Thy wisdom Thou hast made clear to me.

Thou shalt sprinkle me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; Thou shalt wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.

Thou shalt make me to hear joy and gladness; the bones which Thou hast broken shall rejoice.

Turn away Thy face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

PSALM 69

O God, be attentive unto helping me; O Lord, make haste to help me. Let them be shamed and confounded that seek after my soul. Let them be turned back and brought to shame that desire evils against me. Let them be turned back straightway in shame that say unto me: Well done! Well done! Let them be glad and rejoice in Thee all that seek after Thee, O God, and let them that love Thy salvation say continually: The Lord be magnified. But as for me, I am poor and needy; O God, come unto mine aid. My helper and my deliverer art Thou, O Lord; make no long tarrying.

PSALM 142

O Lord, hear my prayer, give ear unto my supplication in Thy truth; hearken unto me in Thy righteousness. And enter not into judgment with Thy servant, for in Thy sight shall no man living be justified. For the enemy hath persecuted my soul; he hath humbled my life down to the earth. He hath sat me in darkness as those that have been long dead, and my spirit within me is become despondent; within me my heart is troubled. I remembered days of old, I meditated on all Thy works, I pondered on the creations of Thy hands. I stretched forth my hands unto Thee; my soul thirsteth after Thee like a waterless land. Quickly hear me, O Lord; my spirit hath fainted away. Turn not Thy face away from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit. Cause me to hear Thy mercy in the morning; for in Thee have I put my hope. Cause me to know, O Lord, the way wherein I should walk; for unto Thee have I lifted up my soul. Rescue me from mine enemies, O Lord; unto Thee have I fled for refuge. Teach me to do Thy will, for Thou art my God. Thy good Spirit shall lead me in the land of uprightness; for Thy Name's sake, O Lord, shalt Thou quicken me. In Thy righteousness shalt Thou bring my soul out of affliction, and in Thy mercy shalt Thou utterly destroy mine enemies. And Thou shalt cut off all them that afflict my soul, for I am Thy servant.

THE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Only-begotten, Begotten of the Father before all ages, Light of Light, True God of True God, Begotten, not made; of one essence with the Father, by Whom all things were made: Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven, and was incarnate of the Holy Spirit and the Virgin Mary, and became man. And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate, and suffered and was buried. And on the third day He rose again, according to the Scriptures. And ascended into heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of the Father. And He shall come again with glory to judge the living and the dead, Whose Kingdom shall have no end. And I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father, Who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified, Who spake by the Prophets. And I believe in One Holy catholic and Apostolic Church. I acknowledge one Baptism for the remission of sins. I look for the Resurrection of the dead, and the life of the age to come. Amen.

Kontakion I

O chosen minister of the King of heaven and great hierarch of the Church of Christ, who didst shine forth throughout the whole world in the confession of the right Faith, and art possessed of great boldness before the Holy Trinity! From all misfortunes shield us who cry out to thee with compunction: Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Ikos I

The Creator of the angels, Who from the ages chose thee beforehand to be a great luminary of His Church, O all-blessed father Basil, revealed thee to be angelic in thy manner of life; for having struggled in the wilderness with feats of asceticism and great contemplation of God, thou didst hasten to the heights of virtue. Wherefore, O thou who hast acquired glory in the heavens, accept from us, the lowly ones who dare to praise thee, these words of praise:

- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, namesake of kingship;
- ✘ Rejoice, great hierarch of Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, unshakable pillar of the Church;
- ✘ Rejoice, all-honorable scion of a holy family!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who from thy youth didst serve the King of heaven with all diligence;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who with all earthly wisdom, and even more with that of heaven didst enrich thy mind!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who with thy friend Gregory the Theologian didst excel in philosophy;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who with all-wise words didst convert Euplus, thy teacher, to Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, all-wondrous preserver of purity and chastity;
- ✘ Rejoice, faithful guide to salvation!

- ✘ Rejoice, refuter of soul-destroying heresies;
- ✘ Rejoice, divinely wise teacher of the whole world!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion II

Seeing the Church of Christ assailed by the storm of the heresy of Arius, and submitting to the call of God, O venerable father, thou didst come forth from the wilderness thou didst love, to the city of Caesarea, where thou didst receive the grace of the priesthood and wast ordained archbishop, proclaiming aloud tidings of salvation to all the ends of the earth, and teaching the faithful all the days of thy life to chant as is meet unto the Creator of all: Alleluia!

Ikos II

Enlightening the understanding of the faithful with the knowledge of God, O Basil, holy hierarch of Christ, thou didst make clear the nature of things, and didst teach them to recognize the invisible God in the creations of His hands. Wherefore, illumined by thy divinely wise teachings, we cry out thus:

- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst enlighten the faithful with the knowledge of God Who created all things in six days;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst teach them to praise His wondrous works as is meet!
- ✘ Rejoice, palace of wisdom, all-adorned;
- ✘ Rejoice, treasure chest filled to overflowing with theology!
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou hast taught us to see the mysteries of the wisdom of God in all the world;

- ✘ Rejoice, for thou hast instructed us to see the majesty of God even in the least things!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst describe the beauty of the primal light;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst point out the mighty power of the first words of God in the universe!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst liken earthly glory to the grass which quickly withereth away;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst show that we are to see Christ, the Sun of righteousness, in the magnificence of the luminaries of the skies!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who by the industriousness of a little creature didst turn the people away from slothfulness;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst order man, the king of all creatures, to gain the rule over the passions!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion III

Strengthened by the power of the Most High, O holy father Basil, thou didst contend against Julian, the apostate from God, and didst beseech the Lord and His All-Pure Mother to set at nought his plots against the Christians, that all might chant with thanksgiving to the one God: Alleluia!

Ikos III

Possessing great zeal for God Almighty, and taking His word in thy hand as a sword, thou didst swiftly cut down the tares of the pagan ungodliness of Julian, and didst make the faithful steadfast in piety. "Teach us also, O venerable

father, to serve the one God alone with a pure life, for we cry out to thee thus:

- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst manfully denounce the prideful Julian for his apostasy from God;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst set at nought his Christ-hating plots!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst wound him with tearful prayer, as with a spear;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst announce beforehand his speedy destruction!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst free the people of God from idolatry, like as Moses of old did Israel;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst uproot the tares of ungodliness!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who hast abundantly provided the faithful with the food of divine words;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who hast watered men's hearts with streams of grace!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who hast admonished us to hold fast the tablets of the commandments of Christ;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who with thy manner of life didst confirm the teaching of thy mouth!
- ✘ Rejoice, good and faithful servant;
- ✘ Rejoice, diligent workman of the vineyard of Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

SECOND STASIS

Kontakion IV

By the power of the Spirit Who abode within thee, O saint of God, thou didst still the tempest of the rage of the Emperor Valens, who was stuck fast in the Arian heresy, and didst give peace to the Holy Church; and in thy holy labors and fervent supplications unto God thou didst chant to Him, rejoicing: Alleluia!

Ikos IV

Hearing that thou, O hierarch of God, didst stand firm in the Truth, and that all the faithful heeded thy voice, the impious Valens desired to turn thee away from the right Faith; and for this cause he sent to thee his governor, Modestus, and later came himself to Ceesaria. But thou, O God-bearing father, wast undaunted by either the wrath of the emperor or the threats of his dread general. And glorifying this thy steadfast confession, we cry out to thee:

- ✘ Rejoice, invincible champion of the right Faith;
- ✘ Rejoice, shepherd who wast ready to lay down thy life for the faithful!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst show forth the steadfast confession of Peter;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst manifest Elijah's zeal for the glory of the Holy Trinity!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst allay the rage of the impious emperor with the divine magnificence of thy sacred service;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst shut the mouth of the heretical general with thy divinely wise words!
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou wast not daunted by threats of banishment and tortures;
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst even desire to receive death for Christ!

- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst endure persecution for the Faith;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who after many tribulations didst enter into the joy of the Lord!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst fearlessly proclaim the Truth of Christ in the face of kings and rulers;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who by a steadfast confession didst show thyself to be a faithful servant of the King of heaven!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion V

Thou wast shown to be a divinely guided star, O Basil, holy hierarch of Christ, illumining the dark night of tribulations with the all-radiant beams of lovingkindness, dispelling the gloom of misfortunes, and pointing out the straight path to the kingdom of heaven unto all who navigate the stormy sea of life, that, rejoicing, they may all chant unto the God Who saveth: Alleluia!

Choir: Alleluia!

Ikos V

They who saw thee to be a solicitous father, O holy hierarch of God, diligently sought help of thee amid perils and sorrows; and thou didst treat them all with lovingkindness, in thyself providing them with a model of true faith. O all-good father, be thou a speedy helper for us also, who are tempest-tossed by sins and tribulations, but who cry out to thee with love:

- ✘ Rejoice, beacon of love shining forth from Christ;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst imitate the heavenly Father in lovingkindness!

- ✘ Rejoice, rich treasure of those who have none;
- ✘ Rejoice, sure refuge amid necessities!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst feed the starving, as did Joseph of old;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who in Cesaria didst found many hostels for the homeless and the poor!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who, like the good Samaritan, didst bind up the sores of lepers with thine own hands;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst heal the ailing Modestus, thy persecutor, and didst save him from being slain by the people!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst defend a poor widow from the malice of the governor,
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst ask of God forgiveness of sins for a sinful woman!
- ✘ Rejoice, father of orphans and consolation of the suffering;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who dost bring those perishing in sins to their senses and set them aright!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion VI

Thou wast shown to be a preacher of the Truth of Christ to the whole world, O holy hierarch father Basil, who dost pierce sinful hearts with the grace-filled power of thy words, as with a sharp sword, and movest them to repentance, that all may chant to the Holy Trinity with a pure heart: Alleluia!

Choir: Alleluia!

Ikos VI

Thou didst shine forth in the firmament of the Church, O father Basil, like a great and radiant luminary enlightening the whole world with the understanding of the true Faith, and driving away the darkness of the sinful passions, from which do thou also free us who cry out to thee thus:

- ✘ Rejoice, faithful servant of the Holy Trinity;
- ✘ Rejoice, divinely illumined elucidator of the mysteries of the Faith!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst loudly proclaim that the Son is consubstantial and the Spirit equally enthroned with the Father;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst make clear to the faithful the truth of the pre-eternal Light which shone forth from pre-eternal Light!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst confess the Lord Savior to be God incarnate and the Creator of all the ages;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst disclose the mystery of the two natures and one hypostasis in Christ God!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who with the kingly power of thy words didst command the rich to throw open their granaries;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who by thy teaching didst turn many away from ill-gotten gains!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who like thunder didst smite soul-destroying drunkenness by thy words;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst uproot hard-heartedness and envy from the hearts of men!
- ✘ Rejoice, zealous instructor in temperance;
- ✘ Rejoice, tireless preacher of repentance!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

THIRD STASIS

Kontakion VII

Desiring to protect the faithful from the assemblies of the Arians, O Basil, saint of God, thou didst adorn everything in the church, and didst wisely set down the compunctionate rite of the divine Liturgy. Many prayers poured forth from thy mouth like sweet-smelling myrrh, and thereby we ask forgiveness of sins for ourselves and our brethren who have fallen asleep, and we glorify the All-Holy Trinity, crying: Alleluia!

Ikos VII

The faithful saw in thee a new Aaron, O holy father Basil, when with divine majesty thou didst serve the bloodless Sacrifice, adorned with the gifts of the Spirit as with vestments glittering with precious stones. Intercede now for the Church at the altar on high, and be thou continually mindful also of us, who cry out to thee with compunction:

- ✠ Rejoice, hierarch of God, who didst receive the abundant grace of the priesthood, as did Aaron;
- ✠ Rejoice, thou who didst acquire great boldness in prayer for the people!
- ✠ Rejoice, wise performer of the mysteries of God,
- ✠ Rejoice, thou who didst adorn well the rites of the Church!
- ✠ Rejoice, thou who didst learn the service of the Liturgy from Christ Himself, as had the Apostle James;
- ✠ Rejoice, man of prayer enlightened by the Spirit of God!
- ✠ Rejoice, thou who during the service was illumined with a heavenly light, as some perceived;

- ✠ Rejoice, thou who wast surrounded by angels, as by certain all-radiant men!
- ✠ Rejoice, for by thy first prayer do we prepare ourselves to partake of the Mysteries of Christ;
- ✠ Rejoice, for with thy words on the evening of Pentecost do we send up our petitions on bended knee!
- ✠ Rejoice, glory and adornment of the hierarchal throne of Caesarea;
- ✠ Rejoice, for to the priests of the whole Church dost thou impart from God gracious strength in their ministry!
- ✠ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion VIII

An awesome and all-glorious vision was revealed to the venerable Ephraim the Syrian concerning thee, O holy hierarch Basil: for one day God showed thee to him as a pillar of fire extending up to the heights of heaven; and later, when he had come to Caesarea, the venerable one beheld thee teaching with a tongue of fire, and with compunction he cried out to God: Alleluia!

Choir: Alleluia!

Ikos VIII

Thou wast wholly aflame with the heavenly light of seraphic love, O God-bearing Basil; for thy words were as bolts of lightning, burning up heresies, but enlightening the souls of the faithful with flames of faith and love. Wherefore, by thy supplications, O father, grant that we may have if only the least spark of thy love, for we cry out such things as these:

- ✠ Rejoice, pillar of fire reducing heresies to ashes;

- ✘ Rejoice, warming fire of true faith and love unfeigned!
- ✘ Rejoice, stern denouncer of the falsehood of the heresy of Arius;
- ✘ Rejoice, ardent zealot of the Truth of Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst put to shame the prideful Eunomius, who blasphemed the Son of God;
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst dispute the blasphemy of Macedonius against the Holy Spirit!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst set at nought the vain belief of Nestorius;
- ✘ Rejoice, earnest defender of the honor of the All-Holy Mother of God!
- ✘ Rejoice, pastor illumined by the heavenly effulgence of love;
- ✘ Rejoice, teacher of the Faith, who didst proclaim words, bearing lightning!
- ✘ Rejoice, divinely planted olive tree, which produced many saints for the Church;
- ✘ Rejoice, vine which bore divinely wise champions of Orthodoxy!
- ✘ Rejoice, O Basil, great and holy hierarch, universal lamp of Orthodoxy!

Kontakion IX

The whole assembly of the heretics was unable to withstand the power of the grace which abode within thee, O holy father; for by the power of thy prayer thou didst wrest from the snares of the enemy a certain youth who had fallen under the authority of Satan, and didst return him, penitent, unto Christ, chanting with thanksgiving to God our Savior: Alleluia!

Ikos IX

Many heretics who were conquered by thy divinely inspired rhetoric and beheld the all-glorious miracle wrought upon the youth, united themselves to the Church, O holy hierarch Basil, Vouchsafe that we also may become faithful and obedient children thereof, who cry out to thee thus:

- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst enlighten all the ends of the earth with heavenly doctrine;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst overcome the dark powers of hell with the grace of Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst free the youth from the snares of Satan;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who didst nourish him with the Body and Blood of Christ!
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst not let a soul redeemed by the blood of Christ perish;
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst beseech Christ to forgive young man who had fallen into the pernicious sin!
- ✘ Rejoice, for thou didst amaze the people with this all-glorious wonder;
- ✘ Rejoice, for by the conversion of the lost one thou didst cause the angels to rejoice!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who teachest us to ask protection of the Lord of the angels;
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who by thy supplication dost cause our guardian angels to draw nigh unto us!
- ✘ Rejoice, thou who bringest deliverance from the assaults of the enemy;
- ✘ Rejoice, speedy defender in time of temptations!

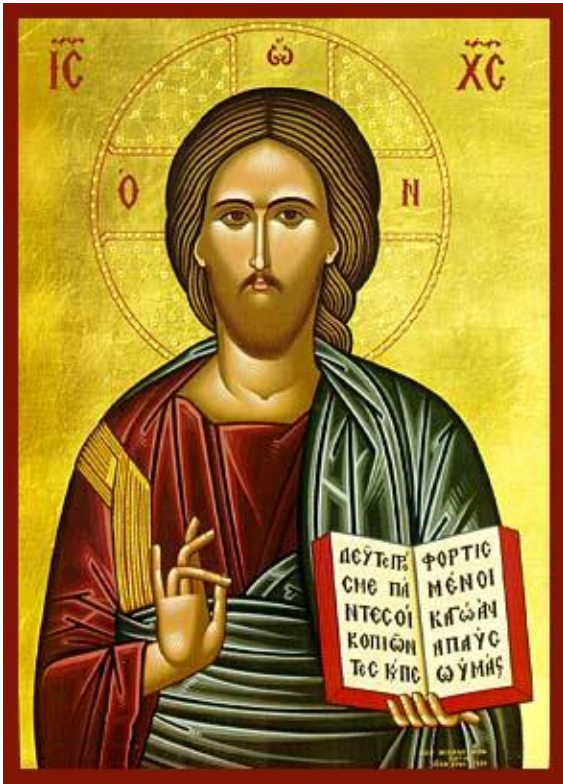
